How does it work?

The school nurse will call you before your child's telehealth appointment.
Your child will be seen by a pediatrician or nurse practitioner using video conference equipment.
If your doctor thinks a prescription medicine is needed, it will be called into a local pharmacy.
A note will be sent to your child's regular doctor.

What are the benefits of telehealth?

Your child will avoid missing school for many illnesses if treated sooner.
You do not have to take time off from work to visit a doctor's office.
You can attend the visit over the phone or in-person.
Your child will be seen by specially trained providers from either MUSC or your community.

How do I sign up?

Complete the forms and return to your school nurse.

Does my insurance cover the cost?

South Carolina Medicaid covers the visits. Benefits vary with other insurance companies, and will need to be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Please contact us if you have questions.
